At the April 23rd meeting, we will also be discussing the amendments from the OASA Annual General Meeting. We will be setting up the W.O.A.A. Softball Program for 2019 and preparing the schedules for the regular schedule teams.

W.O.A.A. PRIVACY POLICY:

The use of personal information in Canadian commercial activities is now protected by federal legislation under the <u>Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act</u> (PIDEDA). This Act applies to both traditional, paper-based business as well as on-line commercial activities. In order to comply with PIPEDA, the W.O.A.A. has adopted a Privacy Policy (this document is available for viewing on the Web Site at <u>www.woaa.on.ca</u>). Furthermore, the W.O.A.A. adopted an "Opt-Out" provision for anyone who feels that they do not want their personal information to be distributed to third parties. This "Opt-Out" provision is at your discretion and should you wish to exercise this option, please indicate so on the 2019 entry form.

DESIGNATED EMAIL:

Again for the 2019 Softball season, the W.O.A.A. will be implementing email communication as our primary way of forwarding and receiving data between the office, Softball Chairman and Convenors to the Centre Contact Person. Each centre must designate an email address that will be used by your Softball association.

W.O.A.A. WEB SITE:

All 2019 Softball schedules will be posted on the revised W.O.A.A. Web Site www.woaa.on.ca We will be posting our Softball schedules and doing our score reporting through TheOneDB. Each team will be given instruction on score reporting at the Annual/Scheduling Meeting.

INSURANCE:

The W.O.A.A. will be offering an insurance package through OASA. It includes a 5 million dollar liability coverage, 2 million dollar Directors and Officers Errors and Omissions liability with accident and \$5,000.00 dental coverage. It is mandatory that all W.O.A.A. schedule teams have this coverage and Bye teams must provide proof of

comparable insurance coverage or else purchase the insurance offered by the W.O.A.A. Costs for coverage are \$67.00 per team (OASA have increased for 2019).

POLICE CHECKS:

For the 2019 ball season, it is the Policy of the W.O.A.A. that a current three (3) years Police Check is required for any individual who is in a position of trust or authority while working with youth (under the age of 19). It is the responsibility of each team, league or association to ensure that Police Record Checks have been completed.

NOTE: This is being mandated by our insurance broker. Each team, league or association will be required to obtain the Police Checks and name one individual as the Designate to obtain, review, monitor and report back to their team, league or association as required their findings; in complete confidentiality.

CENTRE CONTACTS:

The W.O.A.A. will once again be dealing with only ONE person per centre. Be sure that you list the person whom your centre wants in that position on the entry forms. Enclosed is a brief description of the duties of the Centre Contact. Following this channel of command will alleviate problems for everyone.
